Dear Alabama BCIA Members and Alabama Cooperative Extension Agents:

Alabama BCIA is issuing a call for nominations for the 16th Annual Fall Round Up Bull and BCIA Genetic Verified Heifer Sale. Enclosed you will find the guidelines for nomination and forms to nominate eligible bulls and heifers for the sale event. The sale event will be held on Friday, November 11, 2011 at 11:00 am at the Alabama Livestock Auction in Uniontown, Alabama.

Please take note of Alabama BCIA's continued policy regarding genetic defects. Alabama BCIA also encourages all consignors to test their animals for any genetic defects as directed by their respective breed association. The genetic defect status of animals to be sold in BCIA sales will be checked by contact with the respective breed association by the sale coordinator prior to the sale. Any known carriers or potential carriers of a genetic defect will be noted by announcement in the sale catalog, sale supplement sheet, or vocally from the sale block for full disclosure.

Please also review the enclosed birth date and weight chart to find the minimum delivery weight of bulls by birth date. This chart will allow you to monitor your bull's growth to insure meeting the delivery weight requirements for the sale and avoiding rejection. Please also take note, adjusted yearling weights are highly recommended to be reported for publication in the catalog for 16 month to 2 year old bulls. For the 2011 sale, this will include bulls born from August 1, 2009 to May 31, 2010. Documentation of a semen evaluation and scrotal measurements, either by the BCIA BSE Form or the Society for Theriogenology form, must be presented when bulls are delivered to the sale site.

BCIA will again offer the BCIA Genetic Verified Commercial Heifer Sale as part of this event. This sale will target open and bred heifers, calving from January 1 to June 15, 2012, with genetic documentation, group age, and source information. A complete list of nomination guidelines and forms are included in this packet. The BCIA Genetic Verified Commercial Heifer Sale will provide Alabama cattle producers an avenue to expand their marketing of replacement heifers with genetic verification. It is another opportunity offered by BCIA to expand their mission of serving the state beef cattle industry.

The nomination deadline for this sale is **August 15, 2011**. The substitution or withdrawal deadline is September 15, 2011, which will allow for substitutions or withdrawals without forfeiting entry fees. After September 15, entry fees will not be refunded. **Bulls and heifers should arrive at the Alabama Livestock Auction in Uniontown, Alabama on Thursday, November 10, 2011 between 8 AM and 3 PM.** Please call me if you have any questions about the 2011 Fall Round Up Bull and BCIA Genetic Verified Heifer Sale.

2011 ALABAMA BCIA "FALL ROUNDUP" BULL SALE GUIDELINES

Entry Deadline: August 15, 2011

1. Consignors must be an active Alabama BCIA member.
2. All bulls must be registered with a recognized breed association & have EPDs for birth, weaning, maternal & yearling. **All bulls must have a minimum adjusted weaning weight of 525 lbs for nomination. Birth & weaning weights are required to be reported at nomination to meet minimum weights.** ****NOTE, adjusted yearling weights are highly recommended to be reported for 16 month to 2 year old bulls born 8/1/09-5/31/10 & will be phased into a requirement in the future of this sale.****
3. **Age Range- November 1, 2007 through May 31, 2010**
4. Bulls born between 8/1/09-5/31/10 must have a WDA of 2 lbs. All others must weigh at least 1,700 lbs. A 5% shrink will be allowed for delivery weight requirement & for published sale weight as bulls are weighed. **Bulls not meeting the delivery weight requirements will be rejected from the sale at sale delivery when weights are taken & calculated.**
5. The deadline to consign bulls to this sale is **AUGUST 15, 2011**. The nomination items need to be mailed to: Michelle Elmore Alabama BCIA 40 Co Rd 756 Clanton, AL 35045 for each bull to be consigned:
6. Withdrawals or substitutions will be allowed until Sept. 15, 2011 without forfeiting entry fees. **After Sept. 15, 2011, no substitutions will be accepted & no entry fees will be refunded.**
7. The \$100 entry fee per bull is due with nomination, payable to AL BCIA. It will be refunded provided the bull arrives at the sale & is sold. The sale cost includes: 4% of the announced selling price, 1% auctioneer fee, fixed cost of catalog, transfer fees, Beef Promotion & a prorated charge for all other cost to include advertising, labor, and barn rent.
8. Each **out of state bull**, on delivery, must have a current valid interstate health certificate (with lot number and tattoo) indicating freedom from brucellosis (bangs). **Out of state** bulls from a certified & accredited herd still require an interstate health certificate. In order to comply with state and federal laws currently in effect regarding tuberculosis, brucellosis, and interstate shipment of breeding cattle, you should consult your veterinarian and discuss this matter.
9. **A minimum scrotal circumference of 32 cm is required for all bulls selling.** The consignor is responsible for having each bull's semen evaluated within 60 days prior to delivery. **Documentation either by the BCIA BSE Form or the Society for Theriogenology form of the semen evaluation & scrotal measurements must be presented when bulls are unloaded at sale site, if the bulls are to be sold in this sale.**
10. The consignor guarantees every bull selling to be a breeder, for a period of six months following sale date.
11. **Sale order will be determined by EPD percentiles for each bull within breed for calving ease or birth, weaning, yearling, and milk.** The within breed EPD index will be calculated using an individual bull's EPD & referencing the corresponding percentile for the listed 4 traits with the formula:
EPD Index=100-(CE/BW+WW+YW+Milk)/4. Breed rotation will be determined by the number of each breed represented. Sale management has the right to alter sale order if deemed in the best interest of the sale. For example, bulls with low WDA are subject to movement in the sale order.
12. **Bulls should arrive at the AL Livestock Auction in Uniontown, AL on Thursday, November 10, 2011 between 8 AM & 3 PM.** Each bull must be ear tagged with both his lot visual tag & electronic tag before arrival. Both tags will be provided by BCIA. A state premise id number is also required.
13. **Consignors or their designated representative will be required to remain on the premises during sale processing until their bulls or heifers are weighed & penned to verify animals meeting minimum weights & to assist in processing.** General labor will be provided by BCIA & by requested BCIA members. Please make certain that feed & feeding instructions are given to the sale management, if applicable.
14. All consignors of bulls to this sale agree to abide by the rules & guidelines & to all conclusions & decisions of the sale management.
15. BCIA reserves the right to limit the number of consignments to this sale.
16. Consigned bulls remain the property of the consignor until sold in the auction ring. Neither AL BCIA, AL Livestock Auction nor any representative associated with this sale shall assume any liability, legal or otherwise.
17. Sale capacity will be 130 total nominated bulls, in this priority order, Alabama, southeast region, & then national consignors.

BCIA Genetic Verified Commercial Heifer Sale
Source, Age, and Genetic Verified

1. Consignors must be an active member of Alabama BCIA.
2. Heifers must be sired by a properly registered bull that is transferred to the owner of the heifers. The registration number of the bull or bulls must be provided at consignment to the sale.
 - a. For AI sires, a receipt from the purchase of the semen and the registration # of the sire is required. If semen resulted from collection of a bull owned by the consignor, proof of semen collection of the bull is required.
 - b. For a leased herd sire, a statement for the owner of the bull including the dates of lease and the registration # of the bull is required.
 - c. Heifer calves resulting from the purchase of bred heifers will require a statement from the original owner or breeder of the bred heifer that will include the service sires registration #, breeding dates, and proof of sale to the consignor.
3. Heifers must be born on the farm of origin.
4. Group age must be documented (age of the oldest and youngest heifer in the sale group must be provided.) Groups of heifers are encouraged for consignment, but singles are not excluded.
5. Minimum WDA of 1.5 lbs required at sale delivery and will be calculated on pen average with no pen of heifers having over a 90 day age span.
6. Vaccinations recommended will be the following: (all vaccinations must be administered at least 3 weeks before sale delivery)
 - a. 7-way Blackleg (Clostridial diseases)
 - b. 5-way Leptospirosis
 - c. IBR-PI3-BVD-BRSV
 - d. Heifers must be treated for internal and external parasites prior to the sale.The above vaccines should be given twice (a primary and booster) in accordance with BQA guidelines. Either Program A: Primary vaccination 3-4 weeks before weaning and a Booster vaccination at weaning or Program B: Primary vaccination at weaning and a Booster vaccination prior to the sale.
7. Heifers must be weaned at least 30 days prior to delivery for the sale.
8. Heifers must have never been implanted with any growth stimulant.
9. Open heifers will be guaranteed to be open. If any open heifers sold are found to be bred, it will be the responsibility of the buyer to notify the breeder at the first sign of pregnancy, so that the heifer can be returned to the breeder. The breeder will only consider refunding the purchase price of the heifers if they are in good condition and returned prior to calving.
10. Open heifers purchased in this sale or other BCIA Heifer Sales may be consigned to this sale as bred heifers the following year, per meeting the requirements for bred heifers.

Additional Requirements for Bred Heifers:

1. Bred heifers will be guaranteed bred (at a minimum of 60 days) at sale time with documentation from a veterinarian at delivery.
2. A breeding date or date range and the resulting projected calving date range will be required for each bred heifer. The specific breeding and calving date range will be set for

each sale date. For the November 2011 sale, bred heifers should calve after January 1 to June 15, 2012 with breeding dates of March 23 to September 1, 2011.

3. A properly registered service sire that is transferred to the owner of the heifers and the registration number of the sire (or sires) of the bred heifer(s) must be provided at consignment to the sale. For a leased service sire, a statement for the owner of the bull including the dates of lease and the registration # of the bull is required. Low birth weight, calving ease service sires are highly recommended.
 4. A minimum average weight of 850 lbs. is required at delivery for all bred heifers. This average weight will be collected on all the bred heifer consignments by each consignor.
- Sale(s) are invited to be held in conjunction with existing BCIA bull sales. The respective bull sale committees may add additional requirements but may not remove any of these respective guidelines; however, the bull sale committees may omit the addition of bred heifers to fit their sales and sale dates.
 - Sale will have a 2% commission for BCIA. The total commission will be 5%, which will also include 1% for auctioneer expenses and 2% for sales expenses.
 - A nomination fee of \$15.00/head will be required at consignment, which will be refunded provided the heifers arrive and are sold in the respective sale.

Sale Order: Sale order will be determined using the following information.

1. Use combination of EPDs of sire or sires as compared to the current breed average
2. WDA at delivery
3. Input from a screening committee
