Dear Alabama BCIA Members and Alabama Cooperative Extension Agents:

Enclosed you will find the guidelines and nomination forms for the 21st Annual Alabama BCIA EPD Bull and the BCIA Genetic Verified Heifer Sale to be held on Friday, February 26, 2010 at 11:00 am at Montgomery Stockyards in Montgomery. **Two new items for this year's sale refer to sale processing and the new Alabama BCIA policy regarding genetic defects. For sale processing, the requirement that all consignors or their designated representative will be required to remain on the premises during sale processing until their bulls or heifers are weighed and penned to verify animals meeting minimum weights and to assist in processing will be implemented. Alabama BCIA also encourages all consignors to test their animals for any genetic defects as directed by their respective breed association. The genetic defect status of animals to be sold in BCIA sales will be checked by contact with the respective breed association by the sale coordinator prior to the sale. Any known carriers or potential carriers of a genetic defect will be noted by announcement in the sale catalog, sale supplement sheet, or vocally from the sale block for full disclosure.**

Please also review the enclosed birth date and weight chart to find the minimum delivery weight of bulls by birth date. This chart will allow you to monitor your bull's growth to insure meeting the delivery weight requirements for the sale and avoiding rejection. **Also, documentation of the semen evaluation and scrotal measurements, either by the BCIA BSE Form or the Society for Theriogenology form, must be presented when bulls are delivered at the sale site.** A premise id number from the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries (or from the resident state department of agriculture for out-of-state consignors) is also required for nomination of all bulls and is voluntary for heifers.

The Alabama Youth BCIA Bull Sale will again be a part of the EPD Sale this year. Any interested youth need to contact Bob Ebert at (334) 844-1563 or myself at the BCIA Office by November 1, 2009. Requirements are very similar to the EPD bulls, with the addition of being halter-broke. I would like to encourage the youth to participate in this event for this has been a very positive feature of the sale in the past years.

BCIA will again offer the BCIA Genetic Verified Commercial Heifer Sale as part of this event. This sale will target open heifers with genetic documentation, group age, and source information. A complete list of nomination guidelines and forms are included in this packet.

The nomination deadline for this sale is November 1, 2009. All nomination information should be in to the BCIA office by the deadline of November 1. Withdrawals will be allowed until January 15, 2010 without forfeiting entry fees. After January 15, entry fees will not be refunded. **Bulls and heifers should arrive at Montgomery Stockyards on Thursday, February 25, 2010 between 8 AM and 3 PM.** Please call me if you have any questions about the 2010 EPD Bull and BCIA Genetic Verified Heifer Sale.

2010 ALABAMA BCIA "EPD" BULL SALE GUIDELINES

•Entry deadline November 1, 2009•

1. Consignors must be an active Alabama BCIA member.
2. All bulls must be registered with a recognized breed association and have EPD's listed for 3 of the 4 traits published in the catalog. EPD Traits: birth, weaning, maternal and yearling. ****All bulls must have a minimum adjusted weaning weight of 525 lbs for nomination. Birth and weaning weights are required to be reported at nomination to meet minimum weights and yearling weights are highly recommended to be reported for publication in the catalog.****
3. **Age Range – January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.**
4. The deadline to consign bulls to this sale is **November 1, 2009**. The following items need to be in to my office (40 Co Rd 756 Clanton, AL 35045) by November 1, 2009 for each bull you plan to sell:
 - (a) **SIGNED REGISTRATION** certificate with EPD's.
 - (b) Footnote information - limited to 2 lines
 - (c) **Entry fee of \$100.00 per bull and completed entry form.**
5. **Withdrawals will be allowed until January 15, 2010 without forfeiting entry fees. After Jan 15, no entry fees will be refunded. Substitutions will be accepted, by an established consignor up to the original number of consignments, until February 1, 2010. After February 1, 2010 no substitutes will be accepted.**
6. **The \$100.00 entry fee per bull is a refundable fee (provided the bull arrives at the sale and is sold).** The sale cost will include: 4% of the announced selling price, 1% auctioneer fee, fixed cost of catalog, transfer fees, Beef Promotion & a prorated charge for all other cost to include advertising, labor, and barn rent.
7. Each **out of state bull** on delivery, must have a **current valid interstate health certificate** (with lot number and tattoo) indicating freedom from brucellosis (bangs) (**This only applies to out of state bulls**). Out of state bulls from a certified and accredited herd still require an interstate health certificate. In order to comply with state and federal laws currently in effect regarding tuberculosis, brucellosis, and interstate shipment of breeding cattle, you should consult your veterinarian and discuss this matter.
8. **A minimum scrotal circumference of 32 cm is REQUIRED for all bulls selling.** The **Consignor** is responsible for having each bull's semen evaluated **prior** (within 60 days) of the sale. **Documentation by the use of the BCIA BSE Form or the Society of Theriogenology form of the evaluation and scrotal measurements must be presented at the time of delivery to the sale if bulls are to be sold in this sale.**
9. Every bull selling is guaranteed to be a breeder by the consignor for a period of six months following the sale.
10. **Bulls born from Jan-Feb must have a WDA of 2.0 lbs, born Mar-Apr must have a WDA of 2.1 lbs, born May-June 2.2, born July-Aug 2.3, born Sept-Oct 2.4, and born Nov-Dec 2.5 or greater to sell in the sale. 5% shrink will be applied to all bulls at delivery. Bulls not meeting the delivery weight requirements will be rejected from the sale at sale delivery when weights are taken and calculated. Please see the enclosed chart for minimum weights. Sale order will be determined from a separate ranking of each breed by EPDs for calving ease or birth, weaning, yearling, and milk. Breed rotation will be determined by the number of each breed represented.**
11. **Bulls should arrive at Montgomery Stockyard, in Montgomery, Thursday, February 25th, 2010 from 8:00AM until 3:00PM.** Each bull must be ear tagged with both his lot visual tag and electronic tag before arrival. Both tags will be provided by BCIA. A state premise id number is also required.
12. **Consignors or their designated representative will be required to remain on the premises during sale processing until their bulls or heifers are weighed and penned to verify animals meeting minimum weights and to assist in processing.** Labor will be provided by BCIA or by requested consignors. Please make certain that feed & feeding instructions are given to the sale management, if applicable.
13. A veterinarian will be on call for problems arising after delivery and for health papers after the sale.
14. All consignors of bulls to this sale agree to abide by the sale rules and guidelines and to all conclusions and decisions of the sale management.
15. BCIA reserves the right to limit the number of consignments to this sale. BCIA also holds the right to reject animals on the grounds of health concerns and being unsound from the sale. Sale capacity will be 130 total nominated bulls, in this priority order, Alabama, southeast region, and then national consignors
16. Consigned bulls remain the property of the owner until sold in the auction ring. Neither the BCIA, auctioneer, Montgomery Stockyard nor any other representative associated with this sale shall assume any liability, legal or otherwise.

ALABAMA YOUTH BCIA BULL SALE

OBJECTIVES: 1) to provide 4-H, FFA and youth members of National Breed Associations the opportunity to further their involvement in the Alabama Purebred Beef Cattle Seedstock Industry, 2) to provide an opportunity for those youth that have developed small cowherds as a result of being involved in the Heifer Program, to “go to the next level,” and merchandise their bull progeny, 3) to encourage youth to remain involved in the beef industry at the conclusion of their 4-H/ FFA careers, 4) to encourage the expansion of knowledge about nutrition, genetics, performance of cattle on feed and animal behavior, 5) and to reap financial rewards by being able to merchandise bulls in the “2010 Alabama BCIA EPD” Bull Sale.

- 1) Open to any resident Alabama 4-H, FFA or youth member of a National Beef Cattle Breed Association.
- 2) Bulls must be registered by the National Breed Association and recorded in the ownership of the consigning youth.
- 3) Bulls will be sold as part of the “EPD” Bull sale and must meet the requirements of the Alabama BCIA “EPD” Sale, February 26, 2010, Montgomery, AL.
- 4) Bulls must:
 - Be born between the dates of January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008.
 - Have actual birth weights
 - Have a minimum adjusted weaning weight of 525 lbs.
 - Have official Breed Association EPDs.
- 5) It is recommended that bulls be halter broken and able to be shown, with the use of a noselead.
- 6) Bulls must be weighed between September 1, 2009 and November 1, 2009 and the information recorded on the “Youth BCIA Bull Sale” entry form and submitted to Bob Ebert, 111B Upchurch Hall, Auburn University, AL 36849-5625; email, ebertra@auburn.edu; phone, 334-844-1563; fax, 334-844-1519 by November 1, 2009.
- 7) Bulls must have a the following Weight/Day/Age at the time of delivery to the Montgomery Stockyards on Thursday, February 25, 2010 to be eligible to sell, according to their birth dates: January-February 2.0, March-April 2.1, May-June 2.2, July-August 2.3, September-October 2.4, and November-December 2.5.
- 8) Sale order will be determined upon arrival and processing of all bulls on Thursday, February 25, 2010.
- 9) To sell in the Alabama BCIA “EPD “ Sale:
 - Bulls must have current valid interstate health certificates
 - Bulls must have a minimum scrotal circumference of 32 cm
 - The consignor must guarantee the bull to be a breeder.
- 10) After November 1, 2009, other pertinent information about the sale will be forwarded from the Alabama BCIA office.

1. Consignors must be an active member of Alabama BCIA.
 2. Heifers must be sired by a properly registered bull that is transferred to the owner of the heifers. The registration number of the bull or bulls must be provided at consignment to the sale.
 - a. For AI sires, a receipt from the purchase of the semen and the registration # of the sire is required. If semen resulted from collection of a bull owned by the consignor, proof of semen collection of the bull is required.
 - b. For a leased herd sire, a statement for the owner of the bull including the dates of lease and the registration # of the bull is required.
 - c. Heifer calves resulting from the purchase of bred heifers will require a statement from the original owner or breeder of the bred heifer that will include the service sires registration #, breeding dates, and proof of sale to the consignor.
 3. Heifers must be born on the farm of origin.
 4. Group age must be documented (age of the oldest and youngest heifer in the sale group must be provided.) Groups of heifers are encouraged for consignment, but singles are not excluded.
 5. Minimum WDA of 1.5 lbs required at sale delivery and will be calculated on pen average with no pen of heifers having over a 90 day age span.
 6. Vaccinations recommended will be the following: (all vaccinations must be administered at least 3 weeks before sale delivery)
 - a. 7-way Blackleg (Clostridial diseases)
 - b. 5-way Leptospirosis
 - c. IBR-PI3-BVD-BRSV
 - d. Heifers must be treated for internal and external parasites prior to the sale.The above vaccines should be given twice (a primary and booster) in accordance with BQA guidelines. Either Program A: Primary vaccination 3-4 weeks before weaning and a Booster vaccination at weaning or Program B: Primary vaccination at weaning and a Booster vaccination prior to the sale.
 7. Heifers must be weaned at least 30 days prior to delivery for the sale.
 8. Heifers must have never been implanted with any growth stimulant.
 9. Open heifers will be guaranteed to be open. If any open heifers sold are found to be bred, it will be the responsibility of the buyer to notify the breeder at the first sign of pregnancy, so that the heifer can be returned to the breeder. The breeder will only consider refunding the purchase price of the heifers if they are in good condition and returned prior to calving.
- Sale will have a 2% commission for BCIA. The total commission will be 5%, which will also include 1% for auctioneer expenses and 2% for sales expenses.
 - A nomination fee of \$15.00/head will be required at consignment, which will be refunded provided the heifers arrive and are sold in the respective sale.

Sale Order: Sale order will be determined using the following information.

1. Use combination of EPDs of sire or sires as compared to the current breed average
2. WDA at delivery
3. Input from a screening committee
